



Dutch Dogs on Parade FAQs

Where can I find a Dutch costume for my dog? Costume resources are listed at www.tuliptime.com/dutch_dogs.

Do they need to wear a full costume? No, your dogs do not need an entire costume to participate in the parade. Even a bandana will give your dog the Dutch look!

Do I have to wear a costume if I am walking my dog? Human costumes are optional, but if you have one, flaunt it!

How much is it to participate? It is free to register, however there is no day-of registration, and the deadline to register on-line is April 24.

Can I have more than one dog in the parade? You may have more than one dog participate in the parade.

How many people can walk per dog? We recommend one adult person per dog. The walker may have one guest walk with them.

What is required of the dog to participate in the parade? We ask for well-behaved dogs only and that they be leashed the entire parade route. Dogs should be able to walk or be carried from parade start to finish. All dogs must have proof of their rabies vaccination.

What is required of the walker during the parade? The walker must be at least 18 years old. All walkers are responsible to bag their dog's poop.

Where do I go on parade day? Report to the Dutch Dogs line-up area on East 9th Street, between College and Columbia Avenues in downtown Holland. A parade marshal will be there to assist you.
