Special group discounts and complimentary tickets are available to groups purchasing 20 or more tickets for a single event (for most ticketed events). Tickets must be purchased through the Tulip Time Group Travel Manager to receive a discount. Ticket prices in this brochure reflect group rates.

Other terms & conditions – Groups of 20 or more receive group rates plus two complimentary tickets for driver and escort as noted (for most ticketed events). Full payment is required two weeks after the order is placed. Entire group cancellations may be refunded through March 26, 2020 with a 5% cancellation fee. Partial group cancellations may be refunded through March 26, 2020. Refunds will not be offered past the March 26, 2020 deadline. All groups are required to pay a \$20/group order ticket processing and handling fee, \$25/group order outside of the U.S. Any additional purchases are assessed a \$10 shipping and handling fee. Group orders placed after March 26, 2020 require full payment at the time the order is placed. Trip confirmation packages will be sent after April 2, 2020.




